ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS:

The PUAWER competency standards require a level of physical ability to Respond to workplace emergencies where there may be risk to life. One requirement of the training package is that you are to be assessed as being physically capable of conducting an evacuation and providing assistance to those in need.

EXCEPTIONS FOR DURATION OF THE COURSE

If a class size exceeds 15 students, it may therefore also be necessary to increase course duration depending on the number of students.

RE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

The renewal time frame for this unit should be based on the findings of a workplace risk assessment. Commonly, this training is refreshed every 24 months.
