Challenging situations, such as multiple casualty incidents, moving or extricating casualties, or treating potentially fatal illnesses and injuries, are high risk. It is imperative that training occurs to be able to know what to do when confronted with a real-life incident.

This course provides practical simulated real-life situations to learn and gain the confidence to coordinate and manage response and provide advanced first aid in line with legal, community and workplace considerations, Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines and other Australian national peak clinical bodies until emergency services arrive.

Instruction on basic first aid and CPR will be provided, as well as treatments specific to advanced conditions, such as hypothermia or hyperthermia, head, neck, and spinal injuries, using tourniquets and haemostatic dressings for life-threatening bleeding, and managing a casualty in shock. The course covers recording casualty conditions, completing workplace incident documentation and debriefing for recognising areas for improvement, psychological impacts, and seeking help as required.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Participants must have the physical capacity to perform the practical demonstrations, such as 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on the floor and performing rescue breathing techniques on manikins.

Pre-course study:

Students may be required to undertake online pre-course work before attending the face-to-face session, depending on the course delivery mode.

Online study:

Students must have access to a computer, smartphone, tablet, or other electronic devices with access to the internet to complete the online / pre-course studies.

COURSE DURATION

Course durations can vary for multiple reasons, so the durations below are **the minimum possible amount**.

Face to Face contact time of at least	16 Hours
Online with face-to-face assessment Face to Face contact time of at least	6 Hours

Assessment Activities

Individuals undertaking this course will be expected to complete both written and practical assessment tasks. These are detailed in the following sections. Assessments conducted during a face-to-face training session(s) include:

- Perform CPR on an adult (incl. the use of an AED and placing a casualty into the recovery position)
- Complete a first aid incident report form based on the adult CPR simulated first aid scenario
- Perform CPR on an infant
- Manage a casualty with anaphylaxis
- Manage a casualty with asthma
- Manage a choking casualty
- Manage a casualty with non-life-threatening bleeding and shock, requiring minor wound cleaning
- Manage a casualty with a nosebleed
- Manage a casualty with a fracture and dislocation
- Manage a casualty with a sprain and strain
- Manage a casualty with envenomation (snake/ funnel-web spider bite)
- Simulated First Aid Scenario - Manage a casualty with a life-threatening bleed
- Complete a first aid incident report form based on the life-threatening bleed first aid scenario
- Coordinate a multiple casualty incident
