The Low Voltage Panel Rescue course is essential for conducting live work or working with live switchboards. The course covers the performance of rescue procedures from a live Low Voltage (LV) apparatus, not including overhead lines and underground cables in the workplace.

It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a live LV panel and how they apply in transmission, distribution, or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the usual way of doing work. Low voltage rescue comprises responsive operations that involve saving life or preventing injury during an incident or dangerous situation.

Online study:

COURSE DURATION

Assessment Activities

- Inspection and placement of rescue equipment and performing a rescue
- Low voltage panel rescue

Theory assessment:

A written exam consists of multiple-choice questions. All questions must be completed.
